Annual Report for Somersham F.C.

The 2023/24 season will go down at one of the most successful in the club's history with all four teams exceeding expectations.

The under 13s team (the Dukes) has built on the momentum of the last two years and seen some fantastic results. At the time of writing, the team has won 10 games to secure at least a third place finish in the league. A big thank you goes to Steve and Alex for all their hard work behind the scenes. The team is now well positioned to move into the under 14s league next season.

The men's first team has also continued to build of the momentum of last season. The team is currently 5th in division 1 of the SIL league, but with games in hand on those above, promotion to the senior league is still on the cards. This would be a first for the club and see the club punching well above its weight in terms of size. Promotion to the senior league will bring a new set of challenges as we strive to meet the facility and ground requirements to play football at this level. The team has also been on a good cup run, reaching the semi-finals of both the Junior and Morrisons Freight cups.

The Vets teams has similarly had a good cup run, reaching the final of the Norfolk & Suffolk Veterans Shield. Stepping into John's shoes is Dan English who has been at the club for the last 25 years. We've also had a change of first team managers, with Michael Felgate stepping down. Felly has established the team in division 1 and its thanks to his dedication and hard work behind the scenes that the team is has been knocking on the door of the senior division for the last two seasons. Felly is a natural and it wouldn't be a surprise to see him managing at a higher level in the future. We thank him for his contribution to the club over the last 6 years and wish him all the best. We are very pleased to have Clive pick up the reigns as first team manager following the excellent job he has done with the reserve team. We look forward to seeing him close the season as manger of both the first and reserve teams, and to what he can do as first team manager next season.
